The arrangements you make now concerning the final preservation of yourself or your loved ones are some of the most important and enduring decisions of your life.

Eternal Memorialization through Modern Mummification reflects values that represent decades of research, drawing on the most revolutionary science and medical technology, along with the awe-inspiring customs of ancient cultures.

Modern Mummification is not the dehydration method practiced by the ancient Egyptians. It is a very comprehensive, yet gentle process that allows you to leave this life beautiful a manner as possible. Modern Mummification is the only form of Permanent Body Preservation, and Summum is the only organization in the world that can perform and oversee this extraordinary rite.

Because of its nature, the rites of Mummification require more time than traditional embalming procedures. A minimum of 120 days is needed to complete the elaborate and detailed transformation. The investment is worthwhile, as the results represent the ultimate personal preservation that is a truly enduring memorial.

Naturally, the vessel you are placed in is a very important aspect of your eternal disposition. Because your body will be preserved permanently, the receptacle in which it is placed must also be permanent, and it can act as a lasting reflection of your personal aesthetic.

The sarcophagus is an integral part of the mummification rites. Not only does it act as the final protective layer for your enshrined body, it is also an artistic monument that represents the life you have lived.

### An Overview of Your Care

Following funeral services and in association with the funeral home, Summum carefully conducts your Mummification. This includes intricate and detailed rites in which you are bathed and carefully prepared before being immersed in a Mummification font filled with specialized fluids. During this time, we conduct your Transference where we read to you your spiritual will. Afterwards, you are anointed with oils and wrapped in cotton gauzes. Then come multiple layers of a sealing membrane followed by carbon fiber wrappings coated in resins that dry into an impermeable, protective cocoon.

Upon completion of the rites of Mummification, your body is sealed inside a sarcophagus or casket and entombed in a sanctuary or mausoleum – or it may be buried – in the cemetery of your choice.



Mummification is a never ending story whose mystery and intrigue will always captivate us.

Summum's Mummiform sarcophagus is an art form sculpture cast in 1/4 inch bronze. It can be intricately inscribed with symbology and text of your choice.

In place of the art form sarcophagus, you may choose a casket as a sarcophagus. If this is your preference, you will need to select a full couch, 48-ounce bronze or stainless steel casket such as the Batesville Promethean.

Summum will hermetically seal your mummified remains within the casket.

Your final resting place is also significant. As a thoughtful person, consider making arrangements now for your final accommodation. Some important points should be taken into account when deciding where to place your sarcophagus following the mummification process.

Summum recommends your sarcophagus be entombed in a climate-controlled mausoleum for protection from extreme heat or cold. Such a mausoleum can be found in existing memorial parks and cemeteries all over the world.



A suitable mausoleum should not allow the inside temperature to drop below freezing or rise above 60° F (16° C), i.e., an underground mausoleum or a heated/cooled mausoleum.

You may also choose to have your sarcophagus sealed within a triple-reinforced protective

vault, such as The Wilbert Bronze®, and buried in a cemetery of your choice. If the cemetery you choose is located in an area that experiences cold weather, the vault must be buried deep enough that it will resist freezing.
